Children are invited to dress up or come in non-uniform if they prefer.

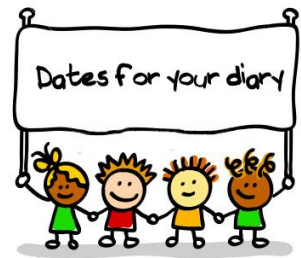
This year, some year groups have a specific theme -

## School Improvement Consultant.

We are continually trying to improve learning and teaching at Flakefleet.

Part of this process over the last two years has been a day's visit each term from Bill Thompson.

Bill is a nationally recognised School Improvement Consultant who works with us to continually improve learning.

Below are two of Bill's observations when working with our children and staff

- Pupils work diligently in lessons, are attentive and responsive to their teachers, and are supportive to their peers. They notice and celebrate the talents and achievements of others and have developed the confidence to try new things, ask questions and persevere when necessary.
- Pupils explained that enjoy school life at Flakefleet. Their needs are attended to, their curiosity is fed and their talents are nurtured. They explained that their teachers invested time and expertise to make their lessons interesting. They particularly enjoy mathematics and writing. If ever there is conflict or upset, staff bring a calm and listening ear to find out how the school can help.
