Diversity - understanding that people are different in so many different ways and this is a good thing that makes the world a better place.

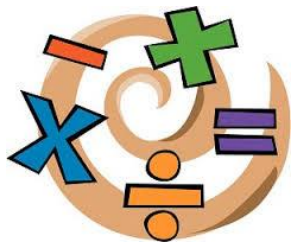


Parents Evenings

Also cardboard boxes eg - empty cereal boxes, egg boxes and then send them into school.

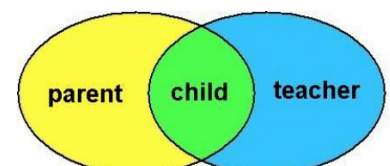
The whole school will be using these to design their own cool cars 🚗 in our annual Science Day challenge.
