## **Reading & Phonics**

Your child will bring home their reading book each night.

Reading is such an important part of your child's learning and regular practise is key. We encourage children to read at home and give out dojo points.

Children do not have to read the whole book, just reading a few pages is a great help. By making a note of this we can carry on in school.

In the book there is a grid of all the different sounds your child will be learning in our Funky Phonics sessions. By splitting up the words into these sounds they will be able to work out tricky words.

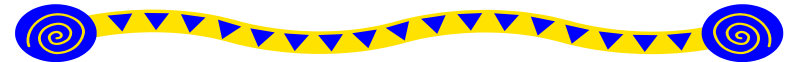
**Please ensure your child brings their book to school as it is used in class each day.**
