## Welcome to year 3!

During Year 3 we expect all children to make significant progress in all areas of school life. We will provide work that will be challenging, in an exciting and motivational way.

As you may be aware, the school building will be open from 8.45am. They will be greeted by their class teacher and will have a morning activity to complete. School officially begins at 8.55am.

**Reading** - Your child's reading record will be checked weekly and they are expected to read on a nightly basis for between 10 - 15 minutes, either to an adult, older brother or sister. Your help with this will be invaluable, please write in their 'Reading Record' which pages have been read, and when the book is finished.

**Spellings** - We will be completing regular spelling lessons in class and spellings will be based on this work.

**Homework** is set each week on a Friday to be completed and returned before the following Wednesday.

**Times tables** are to be learnt as an ongoing exercise. Again there are some fantastic interactive web based sites. We aim, at the end of year 3, to have the majority of children recalling 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10 times tables and it would be advantageous to the development of your child to keep checking their progress at home.



At Flakefleet, we aim to provide the children with 2 hours of **P.E.** per week and therefore your child's **P.E.** lessons will be as follows:

**3ES - Monday and Thursday**

**3CB - Monday and Thursday**

They will **need** black pumps or trainers, blue shorts and a white t-shirt.

If your child has pierced ears then earrings should be taken out prior to the lesson, or have plasters to cover them. Please ensure that all kit is labelled with your child's name.



### Topic Work

During Year 3 we will be exploring many different topics.

We are starting with a topic on 'Healthy Living' this term. Any research at home on this topic would help your child with their class work.

The other topics covered include, Stone Age to Iron Age, Rainforests and Ancient Egypt.
