CREATIVE CURRICULUM:

The Creative Curriculum at Flakefleet involves teaching Science, History, Geography, Art and Design Technology skills within relevant and exciting topics. This year our topics are Earth and Space, Victorians, China and The Natural World.

LEARNING LOGS

Learning Log We will set weekly homework tasks in your child's learning log. This will be set on a Thursday and collected in on a Tuesday. The tasks will relate to what we are learning about in class and may cover aspects of Topic, English and Maths. Each week we will choose a Homework Hero, to celebrate their hard work.

Reading - Your child's reading record will be checked and they are expected to read on a nightly basis for between 10 – 15 minutes, either to an adult, older brother or sister or to themselves. Your help with this will be invaluable. Please ensure book is in school daily as we read in school everyday.

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG) is a main focus this year. We are using a new spelling scheme within school, which focuses on giving the children a deeper understanding of spelling. They will receive 5 spellings per week. which they will be expected to learn and apply in their written work, with a test of Friday

Times tables are to be learnt as an ongoing exercise. Again there are some fantastic interactive web based sites. We aim, at the end of year 5, to have the majority of children up to speed (3 second recall) with all of their tables.
