DOJO POINTS

Children can earn Dojo Points for many things including good work and behaviour, returning homework and reading regularly. They will be awarded a badge and a raffle ticket when 50/100/150/200/250 points have been achieved. Raffles are drawn at the end of each term with some great prizes to be won.

A 'Learner of the Week' certificate will be awarded every Friday in assembly. Parents of these children will be invited to attend the assembly at 2.30pm.

We follow the traffic light system for behaviour. Their aim is to end the day on GOLD with a chance of Afternoon Tea.

HOME TASKS

Home tasks will be sent home every TUESDAY. It should be returned the following TUESDAY. It is expected to be completed to a high standard for your child's ability.

Spelling work will be sent home periodically as we are following a scheme called NO NONSENSE SPELLING. Statutory spellings are ongoing and children will be given lists to learn.

Reading books should be taken home EVERY day and brought to school EVERY day. Please sign your child's diary when their book has been read. Children will complete an Accelerated Reader Quiz when they have read their book and can change their reading book ANY day.

After February, practise SATs papers/revision booklets will be sent home. It is very important that these are completed.

P.E. AND GAMES
